- 1) Does Dahlgren have transportation or a school lunch program?
 - a. No. Parents must provide transportation and lunch for their child(ren).
- 2) What are the school hours?
 - a. 8:30 – 3:15
- 3) Are students allowed to celebrate birthdays at school?
 - a. Yes, they are; however, not with food or candy. Parents are more than welcome to send treat bags for the birthday boy/girl to handout to all classmates at the end of the school day.
- 4) Are students allowed to hand-out invitations to outside parties to other students at school?
