New Business & Points of Discussion

Traffic and Safety Concerns

Recurring safety issues during drop-off/pick-up were a key topic. Concerns included:

- Parents not abiding by the 15 mph school speed limit.
- Vehicles performing U-turns, impeding traffic and student safety.
- Parents using the wrong side of the street for pick-up and drop-off.
- A need to ensure teachers are fully aware and attentive during the drop-off period.
